3-2. Describe how the CoC determined that this project should be eliminated and include the date the project applicant was notified. (limit 2500 characters)

This project was eliminated by the CoC with funding fully reallocated to help fund a new project. The project was eliminated due to poor performance. As an indicator, the project earned only 59 points out of a possible 100 points in the local competition process.

The determination to eliminate the project was made by the CoC's Review and Rank Committee, comprised of non-conflicted stakeholders who evaluated all projects submitted in the local competition, using application materials, scoring tools, and processes that had been publicly posted on the CoC's website. The decision was affirmed by the CoC Governing Board's Executive Committee.

The project applicant was notified on September 20, 2024 of the decision to eliminate the project.
